

## **SUNDAY CELEBRATIONS IN THE ABSENCE OF A PRIEST** What a Leader of Prayer Does

In a *Sunday Celebration in the Absence of a Priest (SC)* who leads a particular element of the liturgy and how it is done differs whether led by one deacon or two laypeople. The chart indicates similarities and differences in the elements and leadership responsibilities for SCs between deacons and laypeople.
