Important notes for trained leaders regarding Supervision for Children's Liturgy of the Word

Our diocese mandates safe environment training for all parish staff & volunteers who have **direct and continuous, repeated, contact** with youth.

- For Children's Liturgy of the Word, one trained adult leads the liturgy, with the support
 of another trained & available adult in the building, who is aware of her/his support
 role (catechist, parish catechetical leader, Eucharistic Minister, usher, other trained
 adult)
- Parents/Guardians who regularly attend Children's Liturgy of the Word, must seek PGC training. Parents who come, on occasion, with their child(ren), they are not required to be trained. However, if they come regularly, they must seek training.
- One of the purposes of Children's Liturgy of the Word is to allow parents/guardians to remain in church for the readings and homily, without distraction. Therefore, a parent who attends Children's Liturgy of the Word with their child, with regularity, is missing out on this adult worship time and their regular contact with the children warrants training.
