

CREMAIN GARDEN DETAILS

The new Cremain Garden, a ¼-acre area located east of the office, is devoted entirely to the interment of cremation urns, either by earth burial in 463 four-foot square burial lots, or in the new columbarium structure, which contains 72 'niches', or compartments. Each burial lot, and each columbarium niche has the capacity to hold two urns.

Cremain Burial Lots

Each cremain lot is bordered on one side by a one-foot wide marked pathway, or by a four-foot wide walkway. In certain areas, one upright monument per lot is allowed, while in other areas only one flat marker per lot is allowed. It is the responsibility of the lot holder to furnish, install and maintain the monument or marker.

Upright monuments shall be of stone, and shall have a base measuring not more than 30" long by 12" wide; the monument stone shall not exceed 24" in width and height and 8" in thickness.

Flat markers shall be of stone, measuring not more than 24" long by 12" wide.

A 12" wide planting area for annual flowers only will be allowed along the front face of the monument or flat marker, to be installed and maintained by the lot holder unless contracted to be done by the cemetery; shrubs or artificial flowers are prohibited.

Columbarium Niches

The columbarium has 72 niches, each measuring 12" x 12" x 15.5", large enough to hold two standard-size cremain urns. Each niche has an interior steel, key-lock door, with an exterior granite panel secured by tamper-proof bronze rosettes. Each niche will be furnished with a 4" x 11" cast bronze tablet, attached to the granite panel, containing the last name, first name, year of birth, and year of death of the deceased; there is a choice of three designs. Tablets may be pre-ordered by the living, with the dates of death to be added later. Niches may be used for two urns, such as husband and wife, or when the two deceased have the same surname; in such event, the tablet will have the surname, the first names, and the birth and death dates of both of the deceased.

The columbarium will be surrounded by four planting areas containing perennial shrubs and annual flowers, which will be installed and maintained by the cemetery.
