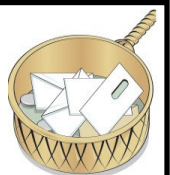

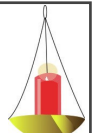
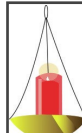
To schedule, use a Mass Intention envelope and please
