WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 17, 2018 - Pick-up:

- 3:45 a.m. - St. Mary Church, 768 Ohio Street, Bangor; depart by 4 a.m.
- 6 a.m. – St. Pius X parking lot (adjacent to Chancery), 492 Ocean Ave, Portland; depart by 6:20 a.m.
- 7:20 a.m. – Wells Exit 19 off the ME Turnpike; depart by 7:40 a.m.

6 pm Approximate arrival at hotel

THURSDAY, JANUARY 18:

6-10 a.m. Breakfast on your own at hotel.

Morning on your own (parish groups) – tour the National Mall and museums (the National Mall is walkable from the hotel – approx. 9 blocks). Museums open at 10 a.m.

8 a.m. Bus to depart hotel for the National Mall (if you'd prefer to ride). Drop-off and pick-up site will be the same and announced upon arrival at the hotel on Wednesday.

Lunch is on your own. All of the museums have cafeterias.
***Please be sure to pick up a couple of snacks to have with you.**
Dinner will not be able to happen until after the Mass.

2 p.m. Pick up at National Mall. **PLEASE BE ON TIME!**

2:30 p.m. Arrival at Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. (This is an EARLY arrival to get a spot in the main church for the Opening Mass.) Groups can reverently tour the basilica during the time.

5:30 p.m. Opening Mass

8 p.m. Depart for hotel. The hotel lobby can be utilized for pizza delivery, there is a Shake Shack just a few blocks down from the hotel, and the pool is open until 10 p.m.
