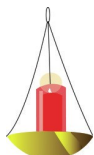

### Sacraments

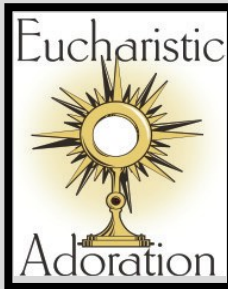
- ◆ **Baptism** – Call the office at least 6 months in advance of the birth of your first child.
