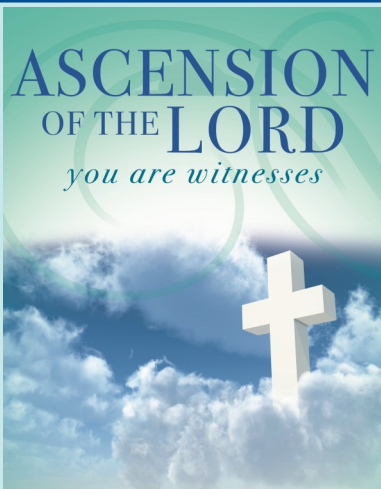

- ◆ **Reconciliation** - Saturday from 3:00-3:45pm at Holy Family ; Sunday from 10:15-10:45 at St. Faustina and anytime by appointment call Fr. Aaron at 485-1921
- ◆ **Anointing of the Sick** - If you or a loved one would like a visit, call Fr. Aaron at 485-1921.

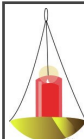

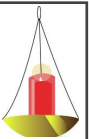
