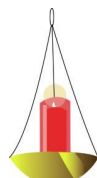

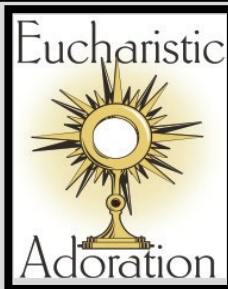

Even though abortion restrictions in our state have been loosened and physician-assisted suicide is now legal in Maine, we should not lose hope. Continue to support Maine Right to Life, local pregnancy care and hospice centers. And continue to educate yourself and speak out on life issues.

To help us better understand the Catholic Church's teaching on end-of-life issues, Suzanne Lafreniere from the Office of Public Policy for the Diocese of Portland will offer at session at each parish entitled *Three Beliefs*. This session will be based on Bishop Deeley's pastoral letter entitled *Three Beliefs: A Guide for Maine Catholics on End of Life Decisions*. This session will give attendees the opportunity to learn about Catholic teaching on end-of-life care as well as how to establish their own plan for such care. The sessions will take place on the following dates at 6:30 pm.: **St. Anthony on October 15; Holy Family on October 16.**

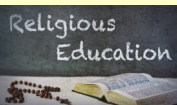
