Totus Tuus is a Catholic youth program for students from 1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade dedicated to teaching the Gospel and deepening love for the Church through catechesis, prayer, Christian witness, and the sacraments.



## MISSION

The mission of Totus Tuus is to inspire in young people a true longing for holiness, a deep desire for daily conversion, and an openness to their vocation by challenging

them to give themselves entirely to Christ through Mary and by strengthening their prayer lives in imitation of her.

## “TOTALLY YOURS”

*“Totus Tuus ego sum et omnia mea tua sunt.”* Thus begins the episcopal motto of the late Holy Father, St. John Paul II: *“I am totally yours, and all that I have is yours.”* With these words, Pope John Paul II inspired and continues to inspire men and women from all over the world to entrust their lives to Jesus Christ through the Virgin Mary. Mary’s total devotion to the will of the Father is the inspiration for Totus Tuus, which seeks to respond to John Paul II’s urgent call for a “New Evangelization.” Learning, praying, and having fun together under Mary’s guidance, participants find a new closeness to one another, and to Jesus Christ and his Church.
